Greenland


- 56.000 population
- 90 % is born in Greenland and Greenlandic is their mother tongue
- 60 % lives in the cities
- 15.000 are children
- 17 towns and 56 settlements
- There are no roads and railways
- Sparsely populated,
- Large majority grows up safe, but we also have a large minority of children that experience neglect, abuse, violence and alcohol abuse.



NAKUUSA - Let's be strong

- 2010 the collobaration began
- 2012 the first Children's council, 9 members
- 2015 Children's Council expanded each municipality
- 2019 the North and East part got their own Children's Council
- 2022 55 members in the whole country
- Nakuusaaqqat (the small strong) 2015
- 2022 26 Nakuusaaqqat out of 80




The National Cildren's Council

Children's Council




Children's Council represents every children in the municipality.
