ROADEX 1998-2025

A trans-national collaboration of northern European road organisations set up to:

- Share best practice
- Research and develop new knowledge
- Implement and test new solutions

On matters concerning the management of low volume rural roads.

Initially supported by the EU Northern Periphery Programme for 4 projects, now funded by the Partners themselves.





Why collaborate? Why ROADEX?

All Partners had the same problems:

- Reducing budgets for roads

- Road materials

- Maintenance, rehabilitation and widening of roads.

The ROADEX solution "FOCUS, FOCUS"

- Precise survey to map the weak sections and focus in on them
- Understand the underlying reasons for the problems
- Design 'fit for purpose' structures and treatments
- Improving the drainage
- Consider the timing of remedial works
- Follow-up preventative pro-active maintenance!











The ROADEX survey technologies

- High speed, non destructive road monitoring
 - Digital video and 360° camera
 - Ground Penetrating Radar
 - Falling Weight Deflectometer
 - LIDAR 2D / 3D scanning
- Cloud based data handling
- Integrated analysis




