We can't sponsor a new sofa for your youth club...

... but we can support a trip to learn how other youth clubs are making their voices heard locally.

We can't sponsor large events like the Winter Olympic Games or summer festival...

... but we can support organisations in learning how nature and culture are preserved in other regions.

We cannot support your research...

...but if you are a University who has developed a new mental health programme, we can help you test it transnationally.

We cannot fund scholarships or individual grants for studying, internships, or training...

but we can support organizations that bring you along to visit others, see what works, and try it out in your own city.

Practical tips for your application

Northern Periphery and Arctic



1. Read the [Terms of Reference](#) – it explains the Youth Call specifications
2. Ask your [Regional Contact Point](#) about funding limits – Norway, Iceland, Faroe Islands, Greenland
3. Simple language, short sentences, no technical terminology
4. Be specific, give examples and details
5. Remember this is a transnational programme – explain why the same results couldn't be achieved locally
6. Show how your partners are complementing each other
7. Clearly describe what you will develop and what positive change it brings
8. Draft a transparent budget which shows a value-for-money
9. Ask someone outside of your organisation to read the application – is it clear to them?
10. Don't be shy, [book a meeting with us](#) or your Regional contact points!
